Develop life skills in an intercultural community. Live, work and play together in a residential program that gives you opportunities to put into practice what God is teaching you. Serve together in a variety of local and international community projects focusing on the care of "the least of these."

### Travel

International travel will expose The Fellowship participants to an awareness of divergent world views. Experiential learning through international travel opens doors for global relationships and important cross-cultural training for ministry.

### Teach

As an old proverb says, "To learn, read. To know, write. To master, teach." As a way to foster learning, The Fellowship participants will become the teacher using the storyline of the Bible as a disciple-making strategy. The best way to learn something is to teach it.
